best Of Koren 13 Days 12 Nights

Day 1 (FRIDAY) : Arrive Incheon Seoul Met on arrival and transfer to hotel. Hotel: Orakai Daehakro Hotel or similar. (2 nights)

Day 2: Seoul Full day tour

Pass by Jogyesa temple, Gyeongbokgung Palace, The Royal Guard

Changing Ceremony, National Folk Museum and transfer to Korean Folk
village. If you want, you will be dropped off at Gwangjang Market where
you can enjoy street food.

Day 3: Seoul -Buyeo- Jeonju

07:45am transfer to a meeting point, parking lot in front of Donghwa
Duty Free Shop Building, at Gwanghwamun Intersection, Seoul.

08:00am depart from Seoul to Gongju, visit The Tomb of King
Muryeong(UNESCO) & Gongsanseong Fortress(UNESCO). Then proceed
to Jeonju to visit JeonjuHanok Village including about 700 traditional
Korean houses called Hanok. After that, check-into your hotel and have
leisure time.

Hotel: Jeonju Ramada Hotel or similar.

Day 4: Jeonju - Gwangju - Suncheon - Yeosu

After breakfast, transfer to Gwangju, the leading city of Honam region and birthplace of a modern democratic movement in Korea and visit May 18th National Cemetery. Continue to Suncheon where you will visit Suncheon Bay Garden. After that, transfer to Yeosu, a port city and look around the Historic Site of Admiral Yi Sun-sin's Path. Overnight in Yeosu. Hotel: Yeosu Ramada or similar.

Day 5: Yeosu - Busan - Jeju

Tour starts from Jinjuseong Fortress - historically linked to Japanese invasion in 1592. Continue moving to Busan and Arrive at Gimhae domestic airport. Depart from Gimhae domestic airport(1st floor, Ticket office of the bus) and arrive at Jeju. Meet your tour guide and transfer to hotel for overnight.

Hotel: 5* Jeju Grand Hyatt or similar. (2 nights)

Day 6: Jeju full day tour

B Enjoy a full day of sightseeing. Visit Hyupjae Beach, Hallim Park where you can enjoy Palm Tree Road, Jeju Stone and Bonsai Garden, Water Garden, Subtropical Botanic Garden and much more. O'sulloc Tea Museum which was opened by Amore Pacific in 2001 with the aim of introducing and spreading Korean teas and the traditional tea culture of Korea. After lunch, take Sanbang Mountain Cruise and Cheonjeyeon falls. Stop by shopping center and transfer to your hotel.

Day 7: Jeju - Busan

Tour starts from Jeju Jeolmul Natural Fores. Next, visit the Seongeup
Folk Village where shows the unique culture of Jeju Island. After lunch,
Visit Haenyeo Museum where exhibits various photos of haenyeo
female divers and their activities, to provide an accurate picture of
their lives or enjoy woman diver show(Unesco Intangible Cultural
asset). Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak, rose 180 meters above sea level due
to a magma flow under the sea over 5,000 years ago and it was
originally a separate island, but a build-up of sand and soil has
connected it to the main island. Transfer to Jeju Airport and *Fly to your
next destination around 18:00. After arrived at Busan airport, transfer to
hotel.

Hotel: 5* Grand Josun Hotel or similar.

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Day 8: Busan - Gyeongju

Enjoy a full day sightseeing in Busan. Visit Korea's largest seafood market, Jagalchi Fishery market and traditional market. Next, visit Gamcheon Culture Villiage, the nickname "Machu Picchu of Busan. This afternoon, experiencing traditional rice cake making with a master and tasting it. Continue to visit Haeundae Beach, the most famous beach in Busan. Proceed to Yonggungsa Temple via Dalmaji-gil Road. Transfer to Gyeongju and visit Gyeongju Donggung Palace and Wolji Pond(night tour). Hotel: Gyeongju Lahan Hotel or similar.

Day 9: Gyeongju - Daegu B
Enjoy a full day tour in Gyeongju. It preserves a vast amount of significant and fascinating historical heritage. Visit Gyeongju National Museum,
Cheomgseongdae Astronomical Observatory, Seokguram Grotto (UNESCO world heritage) – an artificial stone temple made of granites, located on the eastern peak of Mt. Toham. Inside the round-shaped main hall, there are the Bonjon Statue, Bodhi-Sattava and his disciples. It was built to preserve these statues. Bulguksa Temple (UNESCO world heritage) – The beauty of the temple itself and artistic touch of the stone relics are as awesome and fascinating as to be highly praised by visitors from all over the world. Move to Daegu city for overnight.

Day 10: Daegu - Haeinsa Temple - Andong - Pyeongchang

After Check-out, move to Haeinsa Temple located in Gayasan National Park.

Haeinsa Temple was founded by King Ae-Jang of Shilla Dynasty (802), well known for its famous treasure "TripitakaKoreana" (UNESCO world heritage) composed of 81,341 printing woodblocks made to repulse the Mongolian Army Invasion with support of Buddha. Then transfer to AndongHahoe

Village which has preserved the housing architecture and the village structure of the Joseon Dynasty. Moreover, the Village was not artificially created; there are people who actually live there. The Hahoe Village has become world-famous for the visit of The Queen Elizabeth II of Britain several years ago. And then transfer to Pyeongchange, one of 2018 Pyeongchang Olympic Cities.

Hotel: Alpensia Inter-Continental Hotel or similar.

Hotel: Daegu Inter-burgo Hotel or similar.

Day 11: Pyeongchang - Mt. Sorak - Seoul B
After breakfast, drive to Seoraksan National Park of which the peaks break through the clouds while jade-like water flows through the valleys. UNESCO designated this park a Biosphere Preservation District in 1982 due to so many rare species found here. Visit Sinheungsa temple located in Mt.Sorak which is an ancient temple with deep historical significance, built by a great monk Jajangyulsa (590~658). Gwongeumseong is a site of castle ruins located on the steep Dol Mountain of Seoraksan National Park area(Cable car with your own expenses, USD20pp). After sightseeing of Seoraksan National Park, transfer to Seoul for overnight.

Hotel: Orakai Daehakro Hotel or similar. (2 nights)

Day 12: Seoul

After breakfast, pick up at your hotel at 08:00 am for DMZ tour. *Bring your Passports for security check.

Hotel- Imjingak Park- The Unification Bridge- ID Check- DMZ theater and exhibition hall- The 3rd Infiltration Tunnel- Dora Observatory- Dorasan Station- Shopping center- Drop off at Seoul City Hall. Move to your hotel on your own.

Day 13: Seoul Departure B Pick-up 4 hrs before your flights to transfer to Incheon Airport.
